We are a family owned operating service, committed to the developmental and educational requirements of children and providing an unquestionable quality of service. We guarantee to become your child's educational home away from home.

Our privately owned and managed centre is designed to provide a safe, motivating and inspiring learning environment for children. We provide access to purpose built facilities that encourage learning whilst ensuring safety and well-being at all times.

Our Educators have a passion for caring, developing and nurturing children through their early childhood education journey and their most important formative years. This commitment from our Educators is underpinned by their various qualifications in early childhood education.

At My Stars Berwick we place priority on ensuring that our team are suitably qualified to engage with your child and we uphold the highest levels of probity checks. Our Kinder Educator holds a Bachelor's degree and all Leader Educators are diploma qualified. This is further supported with all our Assistant Educators holding Certificate III qualifications. Furthermore, all educators hold a 'working with children's certificate,' are police checked as well as fully trained in first aid, asthma and anaphylaxis management.

We encourage parents and caregivers to experience and feel a sense of belonging with the My Stars family in a warm, friendly and loving environment. Not only is the childcare journey a transition for the child and one of the most important milestones for a child, parents can also feel the effects of separation anxiety. We provide a place where thoughts and ideas flow freely where a sense of belonging is achieved. Once this is established with the parents, the ripple effects can be seen in the child, offering a feeling of security and calm.

We believe in the importance of creating an attractive child-orientated and supportive environment that honours and respects diversity and where the educators act as positive role model in achieving this. We acknowledge the cultural differences within Australia and uphold the spirit and intent of the country. We encourage children to learn and appreciate the cultural diversity of their local communities and the wider world. We strongly encourage and value a partnership approach between families, teachers and management.

My Stars is wholeheartedly passionate about the wellbeing and development of young children. The journey ahead is one of personal growth and satisfaction amongst our teachers and children, thereby creating a stimulating educational experience for all. We invite you to visit our centre and witness for yourself the dynamics of the My Stars family.

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Orientation

At My Stars Berwick, Early Learning Centre, not only are we different but we also do things a little differently. We care deeply about your child's well-being so we go the extra distance to ensure that your child is settled easily into their new environment.

We adopt the following procedures to settle your little treasure into My Stars Berwick Early Learning Centre.

- On enrolment each family will receive a current handbook and enrolment form.
- Parents will be asked to fill out an information form about their child for the educator to become familiar with his/her routine and personal information.
- The parent and child will be given a tour of the centre and meet the educators and children in his/her new room.
- Before a child starts at My Stars Berwick Early Learning Centre, parents are encouraged to participate in an
 orientation process where spend time at the centre for approximately 2 hours. This helps both parent and child
 to feel at ease and familiar with the environment. This process is tailored to meet the individual needs of the
 family and the child and where Educators are flexible and encouraging at all times during this process. We
 encourage the child's independence in getting to know their room without being accompanied by their
 parents/guardians.
- The educator in the room will introduce the family and child to other staff members in the centre so that they become familiar with most staff. We endeavour to have continuity of main carers to help the child settle easier and to best maintain consistency.
- You are now ready to leave the child for the whole day, during the pickup time parents are welcome to a chat carers about the child's daily progress.
- Information about the child's eating, sleeping and play habits will be recorded for the parents to access when they pick up the child.
- Staff remain in constant communication with parents about their child's day and how he/she is settling in and to provide continuity of care between home and the centre.
- Communication books, parent/carer interviews, daily routine sheets, daily evaluations, verbal, phone and email
 correspondence are some of the ways we partner with parents to keep them updated with their child's
 progress.

Parent/Guardian Responsibilities

- Ensuring details are up to date at all times on enrolment forms.
- Sign each child in and out each day of attendance.
- Notify the Centre of your child's absence.
- Report any illnesses or allergies your child may have.
- Complete medication forms when necessary and notifying carers of this.

Hours of operation

My Stars Berwick Early Learning Centre is open Monday to Friday between the hours of 6.30am and 6.30pm for 50 weeks per year. We can operate on the weekend upon request. We are closed on all public holidays.

What to Bring Each Day

- A sun safe hat which covers your child's face, neck and ears
- On cool or cold days: a warm coat, jacket or jumper and warm hat
- Change of clothes (when involved with hands-on play-based learning, your child may get a little messy!)
- A bib or two
- Comfort item (if required), such as a toy or blanket
- Dummy in a sealed, named container (if required)
- **Bottles**
- Expressed milk (if required)
- Nappy Cream
- Water bottle with a lid or a Sippy cup
- Any medications please give these to centre educator to manage directly.

What we supply

Each day, we will feed the children with four nutritional, well-balanced meals as well as healthy drinks. For the children who arrive early in the day we also provide breakfast. We also supply disposable nappies and wipes for children in need.

Structure of the centre licensee

My Stars Berwick Early Learning Centre is a family operated Centre. The Centre is approved by the DEECD. The Centre is licensed as a Long Day Care Centre for a maximum number of 79 children per day and is licensed to operate five rooms, grouped ranging in ages: - 6 months to the school age.

The License is located on right hand side of the wall once you enter inside the centre. Director and owner Pina Rayat, is available 5 days a week at the centre for parent enquiries related to My Stars Berwick, Early Learning Centre. In the capacity of Program Administrator, Pina will assume all responsibility in all matters relating to accounts, fees and CCS Subsidy.

Program and Funded-Kindergarten curriculum

My Stars Berwick Early Learning Centre recognises its responsibility to care for children in their foundation years. Our Centre provides a child-centered program that includes the Early Years Learning Framework for Australia.

The five Early Years Learning and Development Outcomes for all children are:

- Children have a strong sense of identity
- Children are connected with and contribute to their world
- Children have a strong sense of well-being
- Children are confident and involved learners
- Children are effective communicators



Our programming is based on observing children on a regular basis, evaluating their needs and planning activities from these observations. We aim to develop programs to meet the children's needs and therefore enhance individual development. Each child will be pace guided to develop his or her unique, individual way.

Our Programs are evaluated on a regular basis and provide age/stage appropriate planning that considers the needs and interests of individuals and groups to ensure a well-balanced program.

Children's potentials are achieved through opportunities to:

- Be imaginative and creativity
- Problem solve
- Play
- Initiate play and role modelling
- Discover and explore

Our centre uses the programing system called 'OWNA'. OWNA is a secured web-site and app that provides parents/guardians with access to their child individual portfolios, daily information, daily learning posts, observation, reflections, planning and the services curriculum.







Parents/Guardians receive customised username and password to view the child's daily information and progress. Access is provided via email invitation.

Through OWNA parents to have access to their child documenting, photos and artwork every day, all day, at the comfort of their home and for many years down the child's life.

Philosophy

My Stars Berwick Early Learning Centre offers a renewed approach to education that works at catering for the emotional, physical, cognitive and spiritual needs of each child in our care. Through our programs, we prepare children for life and nurture the children at all ages to live happily together as members of a diverse community. From tiny baby, tots to preschool, they learn acceptance and understanding of all people and beliefs. Our Unity in Diversity calendar features multicultural and multipath elements and events that encourage positive friendships and understanding with one another. We believe in the recognition of the uniqueness of each individual child and the need for children to develop an understanding and respect for self, others and the environment they live in. We acknowledge the importance of children, parents and staff as partners in a learning community that promotes the well-being, education and development of all children. We believe that interaction, sensitivity and attachment are fundamental elements in providing opportunities for children to realise their potential and develop a sense of one-self. We believe that the role of adults is to provide a stimulating and responsive environment, where positive reinforcement and encouragement make learning possible. The environment is being welcoming, safe and will offer a sense of belonging to all children, families and staff members. We acknowledge, incorporate, value and embrace the culture and diversity of people within our Centre and the world around us.

Our team, our strength

At My Stars Berwick Early Learning Centre, our team is made up of the most caring, professional and dedicated educators and all children are treated with respect, love, kindness and understanding. Through our in-service programs we build unity and teamwork amongst our educators thus ensuring a happy and stress-free environment at My Stars Learning Centre for both children and our team. The Centre is staffed in accordance with the Child Care regulations. Educators are assisted to undertake various in-service training courses as often as possible and are encouraged to enhance their qualifications.

Parenting

We welcome parents and relatives to participate in our programs and we value a close relationship between the centre and parents. We encourage you to share your talents with us by participating in whatever way you feel most comfortable - prepare for activities, read a story, share aspects of your culture or assist on an excursion. The welfare of your child is paramount. Early Learning Centre looks forward to supporting a healthy open partnerships between the centre and home where your contribution is welcomed and heard. Families are also supported to help create a sense of belonging and unity by active participation in the life of the centre. Staff will provide parents with daily verbal or written feedback regarding daily events and routines through a daily reflection book.

Fees

Fees are payable at least 2 weeks in advance all the time.

Fees can be paid via direct debit - a NO CASH policy applies

In case of permanent bookings all fees are payable for booked days including absences.

Re-enrolment fee is applicable in case your child is re enrolled within a year of leaving.

Alteration / Terminations

TWO weeks fee is charged in the event that the Centre is not notified at least two weeks in advance in writing of any alterations or terminations of the booked days.

Allowable Absences

Normal fees are applicable for any booked days that your child does not attend (including non attendance due to illness, holidays, etc). Child Care Benefit is applicable for up to 42 days absences per financial year (including Public Holidays). Once your child has reached 42 days absences, you will not be eligible for CCS for any additional days absent and will incur the cost of full fees for these absent days, unless you provide approved documentation (ie doctors certificate, court orders detailing custody arrangements)

Late Fee

At My Stars Berwick, Early Learning Centre we endeavour to provide a loving service in a joyful environment. In the spirit of a partnership, we expect parents to honour their responsibility in paying accounts on time. Should accounts fall into arrears, parents will be issued with a 'FRIENDLY REMINDER' and bank penalty fees will be charged due to insufficient funds in parent accounts. If the account is still not brought up to date a FINAL REMINDER NOTICE shall be issued with a 20% administration cost added and the child's enrolment at the Centre may be cancelled if payment is not received immediately. If the payment is still left unpaid, My Stars Berwick reserves the right to hand the matter over to a collection agent to who will recover all outstanding fees from there on.

If you have difficulty in paying your account, for any particular reason, please contact the director Pina Rayat who may be able to assist you. This however should be done before the situation is reached to Debt Collection Agency stage.


The Centre closes sharply at the prescribed time, and any extension beyond that time will be an added expense in favour of the Centre due to Government Regulations regarding staffing requirements, which must be adhered too. Accordingly, the Centre reserves the right to impose a late pick up fee of \$15.00 for the first 10 minutes, after 10 minutes it's a dollar per minute until the child is picked up. This fee is paid directly to the staff who have stayed behind to care for the child, at the time of picking up the child or it will add up to the parent's fee.

Enrolment

Prior to your child attending My Stars Berwick, Early Learning Centre, parents will be given a folder with relevant forms and guidelines required by the Centre. Please ensure the Enrolment Form and Agreement are accurately completed, signed and handed over to the Centre at least 7 days prior to your child's first day of attendance. These forms will enable us to provide the highest quality care and record vital information of your child. It is important that the Centre is notified of any changes which may occur such as change of address or phone number as soon as possible thus avoiding any mishaps.

If there is a court order in place, then the Centre needs to be given a copy of same upon enrolment and the this will be maintained in a confidential manner by the Centre Management. It is most important that the Director be notified of the circumstances relating to this order and be kept up to date of any changes to these details. Should any child or staff member be put in a potentially dangerous situation at any time, the Victorian Police will be notified immediately.

The 4 starts of Child Care Enrollment are listed below:



Child Care Subsidy

The Child Care Subsidy is a payment made by the Federal Government to families to assist with the costs of child care. CCS will be paid directly to the service providers to pass onto families as a fee reduction. Families will make a co-contribution to their fees and pay the provider the difference between the fee charged and the subsidy amount.

Families must lodge the child care subsidy claim online (my.gov.au) by completing the 'Child Care Subsidy

Assessment Summary'



The percentage of Childcare Assistance you are entitled to is based on Three things:

- 1. Family income combined family adjusted taxable income
- 2. Activity Test the activity level of both parents
- 3. Service Type type of child care service

(Hourly Rate Caps and 5% withholding of subsidy will apply)


Centrelink will be able to advise you of your subsidy.

In order to receive CCS, parents must sign every child in and out EVERYDAY that the child attends the Centre. To receive CCS for a child's absence, a record must be made of the reason for absence, including date and under parent's signature. Upon your child's return to the Centre, the parent is required to sign the appropriate day in the folder and indicate the reason for absence e.g. sick/holiday.

CCS Estimator

Families can work out their Child Care Subsidy (CCS) percentage using your family income estimate. Your CCS percentage is the amount we'll subsidise. It will apply to either your hourly fee or the relevant hourly rate cap, whichever is lower.

From 10 July 2023, here is how much you can expect to get covered, on average



*Based on eldest or only child. Families with more than one child may be eligible for a higher subsidy for their second child and younger children.

*The \$12.74 hourly cap applied above is a 2022 figure and is subject to change with the Commonwealth Government's announcement of the 2024 CCS hourly cap changes.

Activity level and subsidised care

Family activity level affects your subsidised care for Child Care Subsidy (CCS).

Centrelink bases activity level on the hours of recognised activities a family does. Based on your activity level centrelink work outs how many hours of subsidised child care you can get each fortnight. In two parent families, centerlink looks at both of your activity levels. They use the lower of yourself or your partner's activity level to work out your hours of subsidised care.

The hours of subsidised child care you can access per fortnight applies to each child.

There are 4 activity levels.

Activity test step	Hours of recognised activity per fortnight	Maximum number of hours of subsidised child care per CCS fortnight
1	Less than 8 hours	0 hours if ATI is above \$80,000 24 hours if ATI is \$80,000 or below
2	8 hours to 16 hours	36 hours
3	More than 16 hours to 48 hours	72 hours
4	More than 48 hours	100 hours

Families can access up to 36 hours of subsidised child care per fortnight if your only activity is either:

- volunteering
- actively looking for work.

To access this amount you must spend a minimum of 8 hours each fortnight doing the activity.

Sun cream

At My Stars Berwick, Early Learning Centre we follow the Victorian Sun smart policy. This involves all children wearing hats for outdoor play which are supplied by the parent, at appropriate times throughout the year. We also apply sun cream to all children before outdoor play which we supply. If your child has special sun cream due to skin irritation you will need to supply this, clearly labelled with your child's name.

Lockers

Each child has a locker, which will be in the same location from week to week. Each day of care, your child's belongings should be placed in the locker identified with his / her name.

Toys and other treasures from home

Please discourage your children from bringing toys etc. to the Centre. As you may understand, we cannot take responsibility for these items brought from home. Perhaps if your child wishes to bring an item to show their caregiver, you can then take it home with you once they have seen it.

If your child brings a toy or piece of equipment home with them that belongs to My Stars Berwick, Early Learning Centre, please return it as soon as possible as a single missing piece can make the toy/game unusable.

Health issues

SICK/UNWELL CHILDREN

If your child is sick and requires medication, then please think carefully before bringing him/her to the Centre. Remember sickness spreads easily and quickly when large numbers of children are in close contact with each other. It is extremely difficult for staff to provide the appropriate care for children who are ill and still give attention to the rest of the group. When children are sick they need more attention and rest and it is impossible to give a child who is placed in a group situation this type of care, as it requires staff members to lessen their involvement with the remainder of the group. So before bringing a sick child to the Centre you should ask yourself - 'Is my child well enough to attend day-care or should they be at home?'

If your child develops any of the following conditions, please do NOT attend until symptoms disappear or your doctor states in writing that your child is no longer infectious and is able to return to the Centre: Diarrhea, Vomiting, Thick coloured runny nose, Fever, Severe Coughing, Head lice, Rashes /severe itching, Cold Sores

THEREFORE, FOR THE HEALTH OF ALL THE CHILDREN, WE RESPECTFULLY REQUEST THAT CHILDREN WHO ARE SICK OR UNWELL ARE NOT BROUGHT TO THE CENTRE.

Parents must also provide information on any Ambulance cover available to their child in the case of an emergency.

Prescribed Medication must have a pharmaceutical-dispensing labeled clearly marked with the child's name, date and the dosage required on it.

Non-Prescribed Medication will only be administered with a doctor's letter stating the name of the medication, name of child, dosage and directions for administration. The only exception to this is the administering of a single dose of Panadol, with your permission, as in the enrolment form.

PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE MEDICATION OF ANY DESCRIPTION IN YOUR CHILD'S BAG, LOCKER OR IN THE ROOMS!!!

Arrival and Departure

Children cannot be signed into the Centre before 6.30am, as they are not covered by insurance prior to this time. It is essential that you sign your child in and out every day that they attend the Centre. These records are used in case of an emergency such as a fire etc. as well as for claiming Child Care Benefit. If this is not followed through, you will be charged the full fee. Children must be brought to the Centre by a responsible adult known to the staff. If for some reason someone other than the parent brings the child to the Centre, please phone and let us know. It is Centre Policy that a person under the age of 18 is not permitted to bring a child to centre or collect them from the centre. On arrival, please take your child to an educator and share any relevant information, which might be important to your child's well-being throughout the day. If your child is upset when you leave, chances are that they will be settled soon after. If you are concerned in any way about your child's wellbeing, please do not hesitate to give us a call. We will call you if we feel your child is unduly upset. Only authorised persons (as indicated on the enrolment form) will be allowed to collect children from the centre. If your child is to be collected by someone other than those stated on the enrolment form then you need to notify the Director or staff, either verbally or in writing. Any adult that is authorised to pick up your child, other than the one known to the staff, will be required to provide photo identification.

Grievances and concerns

If a parent has any concerns, please discuss it with the Director or the Educators as soon as possible. "Nipping in the bud" is far easier than attempting resolve matters that have quickly escalated into major matters.

We suggest that you follow up your concern in the following order:-

- Speak with the Group Leader in the room concerned.
- If you still have a concern, do not hesitate to make an appointment with the Director.
- Should your concern still not be resolved then you may like to contact the Department of Human Services.
